### **Basic Understanding:**



## Bharat & Sanatan: समर्थ भारत, समृद्ध भारत


- Bharat is only the country with the highest 127 Agro-climatic zones

   All our well-known pilgrimage and important trade routes are centered around a River Bank or Mountain ranges.
- Most of the cities in Bharat have Mandirs and even old cities have culture & economy developed around the Mandir premises.
- World is passing through civilizational assertion and in this phase of KaalChakra it becomes more relevant and important for Bharat and MahaKumbh's 65 Cr. devotee footfall is the endorsement to it.

- Agricultural focus should be on indigenous and local products, based on the Consumption, related to economy for the growth of economy
- Focus should be family as unit (last mile) not individual as unit (last mile)
- Cultural Heritage and traditions of the society must be taken into consideration focus on Festivals, Celebrations and Cultural activities, e.g., Holi, Nav Ratri, Durga Puja, Raksha Bandhan, Janmashtami, Pongal, Dhanteras (Shubh-Labh), Dipawali, Ram Navami, Atithi Devo Bhava, Vasudhaiv Kutambakam
- Maatri Shakti not as unit of labor but as a vehicle to carry civilization
- Priority and Focus should be given on family savings to create family-based funds
- Priority to Swadeshi in terms of production and market creation, Vocal for Local
- Bharat centric healthcare, at least preventive and therapeutic
- Minimize the classroom education and shift at early age to Skill Development, Start up, Innovation, Incubation, Education Tour, Bharat Gaurav Yatra, Community Services Training, Various PPP Model, and Internship and Vocational Programs, etc.
- Paradigm shift in development model strategy and planning from Human Centric to Ecological Centric / Nature Centric
- Industrial Development Model / Policy in view Natural Resource clusters.
- Last mile unit should be family not as individual.





We believe, now the time has come as the world is looking at Bharat for taking the role of a 'Vishwa Guru' and explore the vital role of Utilization of Resources, Deployment of Resources, Mandirs as Epi-center of community services, and Eco-centric development Model as long-term strategy:

Ensuring Mandir's participation in sustainable economic model. In ancient Bharat, Mandirs were powerful institutions and a center point of all social and economic activities. Mandirs used to be the sole point of confluence of Adhyatm and Economy. Present generation needs to have proper manifestation to understand and utilised this heritage and time-tested path for Bharat. We believe for sustainable development model and policy; this vision is going to be the base essence of Bharat.

Mandirs were responsible for Education, Medical, Trade and Commerce, Skill Development, and Financial Support. We used to contribute between 25% - 35% up to mid-1800 AD and declined to less than 1% in 1947. We have enough clues that Bharat was always a Mandir-centric economy. Presently, we have more than 5,000 large highly prosperous, more than 2 lakhs medium prosperous, and more than 3 lakhs small economy revenue generating Mandirs in Bharat.




